

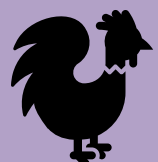
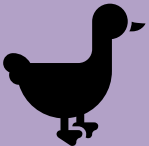




# Year 5 News
