

Swimming Starts Term 4

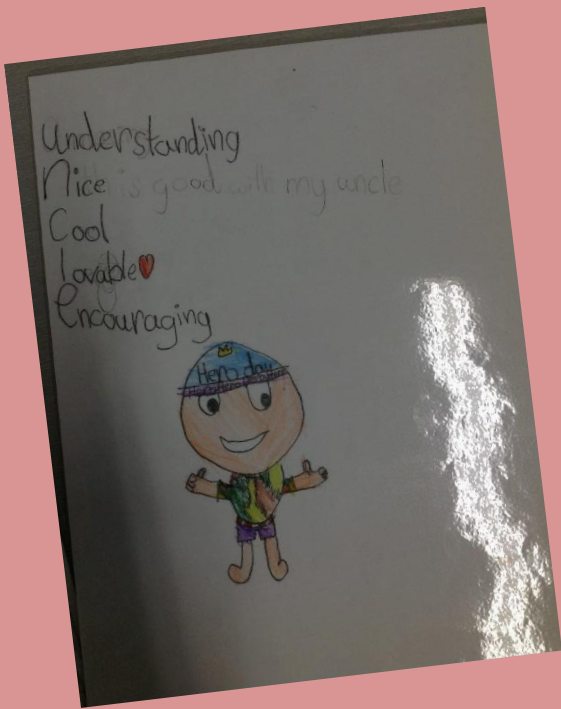
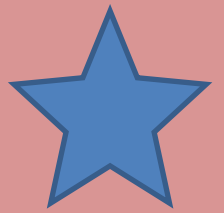
