Our initiatives include

Initiative

- Development of an agreed school template for English and Science for Semester 2 planning.
- Supporting teachers to engage in the 4 step Moderation process (Pre-moderation, Calibration, Moderation and Folio) in English and Science through the provision of Staff Meeting time
- Embedding the use of the Literacy Continua to inform goal setting, track student progress and shape teaching and learning.
- Develop teachers capacity to embed effective, consistent literacy block sessions 3 times a week.
- Develop and embed school-wide planning and quality assurance processes to ensure the school's curriculum is enacted across the school, supporting staff with quality feedback in order to build their capacity to plan and deliver the curriculum.
- Collaboratively develop and implement a collegial framework that documents professional capability development for all school staff including observation, coaching, mentoring and feedback

Employ a teacher aide 20 hours week to work with students in Prep and Year 1, developing early reading skills, co-ordinating the Big 6 interventions delivering explicit vocabulary and speech programs	\$47,943
Employ a Head of Curriculum (0.8) to oversee effective curriculum development and delivery, drive the focus on improving reading outcomes across all year levels and support the embedding of the Literacy Continuum.	\$120,000
